



What: **Summer Evening Team Score event**
-with optional picnic
Where: **Concord College, Acton Burnell**
When: **13th July 2021**

Come and catch up. A three-person team score event around the delightful grounds of an empty school. Bring a picnic, go orienteering and spread out on the grass, in the shade or shelter under some trees. By having a short start period everyone should finish in a similarly short period and thus socially distanced interaction and picnics can be facilitated.

Important Note: Anyone who has symptoms of Covid-19, who is living in a household with someone who has a possible or confirmed Covid -19 infection, or who has been asked to isolate by NHS Test and Trace, must stay at home.

Outside please maintain 1m+ social distancing from those not in your household at all times. Masks optional.

Venue: Concord College, Acton Burnell SY5 7PF. Note the main entrance is not in Acton Burnell village.

Event site: Grid ref SJ 5380 2192. Turn towards Kenley and Highley from the road through Acton Burnell. College main gate is on the right after 500m. **Your temperature will be taken by Concord staff on arrival at the Main gate.** Parking is on the College car park- please park compactly with consideration for social distancing with orienteers and anyone else.

Format

Teams of 3 runners who collect three maps and then start at the same time. Each person to visit all the controls on their map as quickly as they can. The team time is taken when the last person finishes their course. Expected finish times will be around 20-25 minutes for all courses.

Each missed control will incur a penalty of 5 minutes to be added to the team time. Teams can gather before going to the finish to check that all controls have been visited. If any control has been missed any member of the team can be sent to dib it, but they will need the right dibber.

Teams

The plan is that the organisers make up evenly matched teams of three from the entry list. If you want to enter as a team, please do this in an appropriate spirit of fairness. Please use the entry form to show this. Some handicapping of teams might happen to make it all fairer.

WHAT TO DO

When you arrive check the list in the Car Park to find out who is in your team.

Collect team together and as soon as you are ready. Go to the start and START as directed. Teams will start one team at a time as quickly as it can be organised...

You must punch the start and finish dibber boxes by hand.

After you finish we are hoping that the weather and other factors will enable us to have a sociable picnic

Terrain: College building campus and ground. One area of long grass, some tarmac, some playing fields.

Map: 1:3000, 5m contour printed on A4.

Sportident: Electronic punching will be used. Dibbers available to borrow-use entry form below. Lost dibbers will be charged at £40.

Registration: Team lists and dibbers to collect in Car Park

Starts: Between 1845 and 1915 as teams turn up.

Facilities: Toilets available close by.

Dogs: Dogs allowed but must be kept under control and leave no trace of their presence.

Safety: Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety.

This is essentially a traffic free site BUT Orienteers will be visitors to the site and there are a few site residents. All courses cross the carparking area and the school drive. **Be careful and avoid traffic.**

In case of good weather cagoules may not be compulsory.

Please remember to download after your run, or a search will take place for you. Full leg cover is not required.

In the event of extreme weather please check the WREKIN orienteers website or Facebook page to check the event is still happening. It would have to be quite extreme.
