**Venue:** PGL, Boreatton Park is located near to Baschurch. From Baschurch follow the brown tourist signs for "PGL Activity Centre" Nearest Postcode: SY4 2EX. Grid Ref: SJ 40560 24166

**Car Parking:** On-site hard surface parking. £1. Once through the barrier, follow the red line on the ground to the car park, and then the directions of the parking marshalls.

**Map:** 1:5,000 with 5m contours, A3 on waterproof paper. Updated 2018. Loose descriptions are available.

**Terrain:** A mixture of woodland, open areas, building, and many distinct features.

**Courses:** Yvette Baker Trophy Courses: Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Green.

West Midland League courses: White, Yellow, Orange, Light Green, Short Green, Green, Blue, Brown.

Shadowing is not permitted, but pairs are permitted on the yellow course.

West Midland League and all other entries are Entry on the day.

Seniors £8, Non BOF members £10. Juniors including Yvette Baker Trophy £3.

**Registration:** Open 10am-12:00pm. Starts: 10:30am till 12:30pm. Courses close at 14:30pm.

**Facilities:** Toilets. **No muddy shoes in the toilets please.** Refreshments to be confirmed.

**Sportident:** Electronic punching will be used. Touch free punching will be enabled. All competitors must punch the start and the finish. Standard dibbers available to hire £1.

**Safety:** Whistles must be carried. In case of bad weather cagoules will be compulsory. Competitors take part at their own risk and are responsible for their own safety. Please remember to download after your run, or you will be deemed as missing and a search will take place for you. Full leg cover is required.

**All Activity equipment is Out of Bounds. You may run across /through it, but you must not stop and play on it/climb it. All lakes/ponds, large and small must not be entered no matter how shallow they may look. All uncrossable features marked must not be crossed. There is one metal fence in particular that is barbed wire topped. Please use the crossing point to cross it. Please take care if running on wooden boarding it can be very slippery if it is wet. Areas marked with red hatchings are Out of Bounds and must not be entered. If you see another competitor breaking these rules you must report them at download, and they will be disqualified.**

**Dogs:** Sorry no dogs allowed on site, this is children's activity centre.
